York County Clerk of Courts – 2010 Activity/Accomplishments

In 2010 the Clerk of Courts filed 7,630 criminal cases down from 7,762 in 2009 representing a declining trend over the past two years. Delinquencies were up by 8% to 869 cases in 2010. Overall the Clerk's office processed a total of 12,336 cases in all case categories – Administrative, Criminal, Miscellaneous, Juvenile Delinquency, Juvenile Dependency and Summary Appeals.

In 2010 the Clerk's office recorded 315,737 docket entries down from the 319,666 created in 2009. The Clerk of Courts staff clerked 16,510 court case events involving 13,290 defendants in 2010.

In 2010 the Clerk's office prepared 535 State Correctional Institution commitments down from 604 in 2009. Additionally 199 Superior Court Appeals were processed down from 243 in 2009 and 1,709 cases were expunged in 2010 vs. 1,515 in 2009. Real time imaging or the electronic capture of paper filings continued in 2010 with 1,196,845 pages scanned up from 1,110,631 in 2009 for a total of 7.7 million+ pages of court documents instantly available via the Internet to the courts, authorized agencies and law offices.

In 2010 the Costs and Fines Unit deposited a total of \$9,329,730.52– up by **\$1,302,784.87** or **16%** over 2009's total. Percentage payments to the third party collections vendor, Credit Management Company, are listed for the first time in 2010 in the below spreadsheet.
